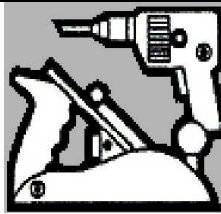

Max explained about 3-4-6 teeth blades, how to use the different teeth blades, how the different blades were made, all blades are now imported, and how to measure the blade length when ordering a new blade. The evening was very informative.

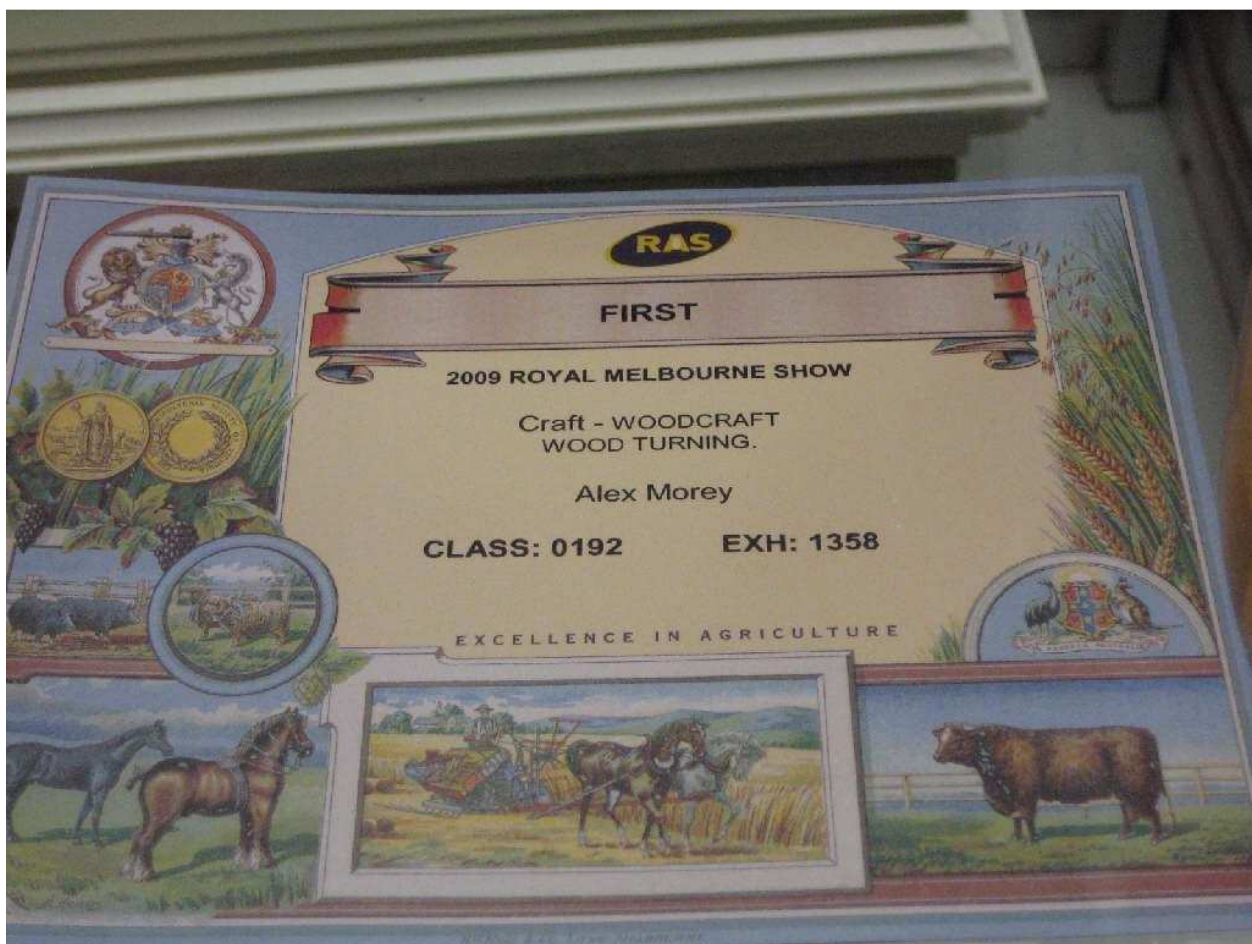

So I headed to the local Sears on a Friday night, arriving about 15 minutes before closing.



With the PA announcing shoppers should take their purchases to a register, I headed right to the tool department and picked out what I guessed was the best corded jigsaw they had. It was a panic decision. I hadn't done any research or even used a barrel grip jigsaw ever before. I grabbed an ample supply of blades and planned to rough out the blanks the next morning. The jigsaw was awesome, shaving hours from the process and working smooth as silk. I've had that Jigsaw going on 16 years now and it is still among my favorite tools. Not just because it works well, but also because it helped me craft a nice gift for two people I really love.
