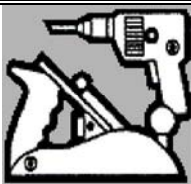

In the month of June the turning group has met the challenge launched by Peter Stacey.

**Peter Stacey** brought in green timber, acel variety and set a challenge for members using these pieces (within the next fortnight) to make something unusual. Peter showed three examples.

**Hans Kopp** showed 2 large gentlemen's pens, one lidded container and one mushroom with offset turned stem, and two most attractive inside outside candlestick holders. Next time he showed a lidded container with acrylic insert in the lid, a needle holder of Japanese maple, laminated with lemon scented gum and three inside outside candlesticks.

**Mark Gehrmann** showed a picture of acrylic for pens, one metre long at a cheaper price than shorter lengths that are available

**Bill David** showed a red gum crank shaft.

**Daniel Wassef** showed 2 pens, one of Tasmanian hardwood and one oak.

**Bob Lorensene** has asked members to demonstrate at July club night.

Four or five members have volunteered to operate lathes, all making something different and perhaps one showing sharpening. Bob showed a beautiful rosewood lidded container with the wonderful aroma of roses, a mahogany semi sphere shaped lidded box, a mushroom of berberis timber.

**Peter Grant** showed a lidded container of silver birch, finishing with triple EEE and shallow wax.

**Russell Painter** showed a piece of apricot timber with natural edge turned into an interesting dish on its own base.

**Helene Longton** showed a small sheoak dish, a sassafras bowl, a camphor laurel lidded container and a small lighthouse of green acel.

**Peter Stacey** showed his pieces, a green acel goblet and candlestick.

**Praveen Nathaniel** showed a dainty scent pot of acel.

**Ian Haynes** showed a pen made from cat's claw timber.
